

August Scrapbook Page



For this page I used a photo which was 12cm x 8cm but there is scope with this page to use a different size or even two overlapping photographs if you wish.

1. Cut out the pre stamped sections of your card stock to form 3 decorative panels. These can be kept as rectangles or you can use your dies if you wish. If you have Distress Inks the edges of the panels can be lightly inked with a sepia/vintage tone.
2. Glue the cream net strip to the right side of the page in a vertical direction approx 3cm I from the edge, if you use glue or tape in the middle section this will be covered later.
3. Arrange your three printed panels and photograph in an overlapping arrangement as shown in the photograph. I tucked a corner of my photo underneath one of the panels.
4. Arrange the pink net strip to the bottom section approx 6 cm up, you may need to trim you net.

5. Arrange your cotton lace trim to the right side over the top of the panels approx 7 cm in from the edge, this does not reach from top to bottom and should sit in the middle section.
6. Fix your pink vintage ribbon across the page over the top of the pink net and fasten with tape on the back of the page.
7. Slide one of the buckles over the brown velvet ribbon and stick this below the pink ribbon, then stick the beige ribbon below this.
8. Open out your Zip by removing all the metal fixings with pliers. You will then have two strips. With a needle and thread gather up a section of zip so that it coils round in a flower shape and fasten off the stitching.
9. Arrange all the remaining decorative elements in the corner section and glue into place. It is best to keep the elements close together as a focal point.
10. Use the tacks provided to add extra detail as preferred. I chose to swirl mine but you could do a line or the corners of the panels or even a heart shape. I found it easier to attach the backs with a dab of glue as they were inclined to 'ping' off when the page was bent.
