

December Scrapbook Page



1. Cut around the design on the blue paper to create a cloudy skyline and trim to 10 inches wide. Adhere this to the top section of the white page leaving a border.
2. Cut a strip of the trees paper 2.5 x 10 inches
3. Cut a strip of green stitch paper 3.5 x 10 inches
4. Adhere these strips in place; there should be a clear border of white page showing all around.
5. Cut a strip of the bright stripe paper 1 x 10 inches and fix 2.5 inches up from the bottom of the page.
6. Cut a strip of the black stripe paper 1/2 inch x 10 inches and fix 2 inches up from the bottom of the page.
7. Trim and mount your main photograph onto white card. Optional - Cut insert picture into a 2 1/2 circle and mount onto a slightly larger circle.
8. Cut a strip of beige card for the house approx 2 1/2 inches x 4 1/2 inches. Mark at one end of the strip approx 1 1/2 inches across the centre point. Cut freehand from bottom corners to the top marks to make a house shape which narrows towards the top.
9. Use the same technique to create the roof from striped paper; it should end up approx 2 1/2 inches at the bottom edge and 1 1/2 inches at the top edge. Cut a wiggly edge at the bottom.
10. Position the photograph slightly to the right of the centre and the inset picture below this to the left. Fix the house in place next to the main picture.
11. Cut 4 thin windows from the black stripe paper and fix in position.
12. Cut two paisley shapes and fix these in the bottom right hand corner.
13. Use a fine black pen to add some faux stitch lines around the house.
14. A 'Safmat' title has been provided, this can be cut into two section and added to the top and bottom of the page. Simply peel away from the backing and rub down.
