

## October Scrapbook Page



You will need a photograph approx 5½ inches by 4 inches

1. Cut out the stamp edge from your lime paper; this has been marked on the reverse. With a fine pen in either purple or black draw some small dashed lines around the edge for faux stitching detail.
2. Glue this paper onto the purple cardstock.
3. Cut three flowers from patterned paper using the template provided.  
Optional -Stamp across the flowers with a small flower or flourish design stamp and purple ink for extra detail. Draw some small dashed lines around all the petals as faux stitching.
4. For the largest flower choose the largest mirror tile and cut a green circle a little larger to layer this onto. Attach these to the centre of the large flower. There are holes in the mirror and this can be stitched to the flower if you wish with contrasting thread.
5. Repeat the process for the other two flowers, although they do not need the extra paper circle in the centre.
6. Mount your photograph onto green paper and add detail around the edge with faux stitching as before.
7. Cut three stems for your flowers from green Bazzil 2-3 mm wide.
- 8 Optional – on the background paper there are lines of daisy chain stitching, I have drawn over this with a purple pen to make it more prominent.
9. Assemble the page as shown with the photograph to the top left and the flowers to the right at different heights. Mark faux stitching lines down the length of the stems on the right side only.
10. Choose your title from the alphabet and ink the edges of the tiles to disguise the white. Position the title across the bottom of the page.
